

Construction Update

Chambers Flat Road Upgrade

November 2023

SEE Civil is the appointed contractor to construct the 3.8 km Chambers Flat Road upgrade between Mount Lindesay Highway to just north of Kings Way.



Current works

Zone 1 - Munruben Ambulance Station to Norris Creek Road and **Zone 2** - 1866 Chambers to 1737 Chambers Flat Road

- > **Upgrading Norris Creek Road intersection is continuing over coming weeks, with potential night works (residents will be notified) to minimise disruption to road users**
- > Building layers of gravel on the new alignments
- > Constructing pavement, drainage and driveways
- > Asphaltting and sealing
- > Installing road and driveway drainage
- > Plant and truck activity for earthworks
- > Telstra relocation works
- > Road reserve works, batter treatments and landscaping.

Zone 3 - Norris Creek Bridge (pictured left)

- > **We have reached another positive milestone for the project with rapid progress at the Norris Creek Bridge site**
- > Piling started in mid-October is now complete
- > Significant work is underway for the next phase including pouring the 8m-high concrete columns and 10m-high headstocks.
- > Early morning starts may be necessary to avoid summer heat impacts on concrete pour temperatures
- > Residents can expect noise and vibration reduction during this phase
- > Beams and deck units have been built off-site and after curing will be installed early next year.

Zone 4 - 1545 Chambers Flat Road to Riverina Court

- > **Reconstructing Kings Way paving and road reserve works**
- > Undertaking intersection tie-in works to the new section of Chambers Flat Road
- > Constructing pavement, sealing, and asphaltting
- > Installing road and driveway drainage
- > Plant and truck activity for earthworks
- > Installing watermain protection slabs and relocation works
- > Constructing the new bus stop
- > Installing road signs and line marking
- > Landscaping.

What to expect

- > Temporary traffic changes — reduced speed, assisted property access and traffic controls for moving plant and equipment
- > Lane switching for work on opposite lane
- > Driving on unsealed surfaces
- > Odour during asphaltting and sealing
- > Increased truck movements
- > Temporary changes to property access and driveway gradients which may cause issues for lowered cars
- > Providing steel plate during property driveway works to maintain access when required
- > Changes to waste bin collection to accommodate the eastbound closure
- > Increased noise, dust and vibration
- > Regular watering to aid dust control
- > Advance letterbox notification of works
- > Email/ phone advice for directly impacted residents
- > Drone flights intermittently to capture progress and assist engineering
- > Weather and site conditions may impact scheduled work hours
