**Policy title:** PERMIT FOR EXTRAORDINARY TRAFFIC  
**Directorate:** TRANSPORT AND WATER SERVICES  
**Branch:** ROAD INFRASTRUCTURE PLANNING  
**Policy objective:** To ensure that house removals in the Logan City area are transported with minimal inconvenience to the local area.

**Policy scope:**

This policy will apply to house removalists to obtain a permit for extraordinary traffic in compliance with Subordinate Local Law No. 11.1 (Interference with Local Government Roads) 2003.

**Definitions:**

Not applicable.

**Policy statement:**

The following procedure is to be undertaken for this policy:

1. When removal buildings, traffic loads that are over dimensioned, over sized loads or extraordinary heavy loads are being transported to or from a property in Logan, or passing through the city by road other than a state controlled road or a declared road, the removalist must be in possession of a permit for extraordinary traffic issued by the National Heavy Vehicle Regulator (NHVR).
2. Road Manager Consent (or refusal) will be issued to NHVR in accordance with guidelines established under Heavy Vehicle National Law and in compliance with the Council's Subordinate Local Law No. 11.1 (Interference with Local Government Roads) 2003, subject to receipt of all necessary information being provided through a Road Manager Consent Request from NHVR.
3. There are no Council fees or charges for Road Manager Consents. However, in cases where more detailed or costly assessment is required, Council is able to request and negotiate for the assessment and/or assessment costs to be borne by the applicant.
