

# Application for Exemption from Waste Disposal Charges – Residents Without a Bin Service

## Conditions of Application

I acknowledge that:

- I am only eligible to be exempted from waste disposal charges at Logan City Council waste and recycling facilities while I do not have a Council-provided bin service at my residential address.
- Once my application is successfully processed, I will be issued with a Certificate of Exemption from waste disposal charges valid for the financial year.
- The Certificate of Exemption entitles the holder to dispose of a quantity of waste approximately equivalent to the contents of one waste wheelie bin weekly. The Certificate of Exemption is capped at 52 uses per year, monitored by QR Code. Disposal of waste in excess of this quantity must be paid for in accordance with Council's Schedule of Waste Disposal Charges.
- On each occasion that the Certificate of Exemption is presented at a waste and recycling facility, the person holding the Certificate must also present photo identification showing their Logan address.
- The original of the Certificate of Exemption must be presented on each occasion that household waste is tipped. Presentation of a photocopy of the Certificate of Exemption will not be accepted. If the original Certificate is lost contact Council for a replacement.
- Certificates of Exemption are reviewed each financial year and renewed automatically. You are not required to re-apply. If your property is no longer eligible e.g., your area becomes serviceable, we will advise you in writing that your Certificate of Exemption is not renewed, and a bin service now applies.
- Council will maintain a register of Certificates of Exemption that have been issued. The register is regularly reviewed. Certificates of Exemption will be cancelled if a Council bin service is requested for the subject property.
