East Street to Monmouth Court and John Collins Drive to Collins Creek Road
Project update, August 2023



Mundoolun Road Rehabilitation

Logan City Council is upgrading 4.5 km of Mundoolun Road, from south of the East Street/Edelsten Road roundabout to just north of Monmouth Court, and from John Collins Drive to Collins Creek Road.

This project is funded in part by the Australian Government 2022–23 Roads to Recovery Program.

The upgrade will:



Improve the road condition and extend the life of the pavement



Improve safety as traffic grows



Reduce the frequency and duration of road closures due to flood events

Project forecast:

Works are progressing as planned. It is anticipated that by the end of August 2023:

- > the road within the project area will be completely resurfaced
- > temporary traffic signals will be removed with local traffic control arrangements in place around remaining work zones.

These milestones are subject to weather and construction conditions.

Progress update, January to July 2023

Since commencing in January 2023, we've completed the following activities:

- > removal of vegetation and tree clearing
- > excavation works
- > installation of new box culverts and restoration of affected driveway
- > relocation of telecommunication services
- > installation of temporary traffic safety barriers, signage, and fencing
- > temporary closure of the bus stop at the Green Ridge Road and Mundoolun Road junction
- > road raising in some sections to improve flood resilience.

We thank motorists and residents for their cooperation and patience while we undertake these essential works.

Staying safe around road works



Construction involves a variety of activities, and ensuring the safety of workers and road users is critical.

We ask that you:

- > remain clear of construction works
- > observe traffic control measures including traffic lights
- > follow instructions from traffic control officers assisting motorists safely around works
- > follow signage and pedestrian paths

Bus stop relocation

The bus stop at Green Ridge Road and Mundoolun Road junction will be relocated 100m north towards Mona Drive. A pullover bay at the new bus stop will enable buses to stop safely, making it easier for passengers to get on and off.

Local schools, and public and private transport operators will be advised in advance to plan service changes and determine access arrangements.



A better road surface to keep you moving

Following a successful trial, we have introduced an innovative foam bitumen treatment for a stronger, more flexible, and durable road.

The foam bitumen is also more resistant to damage from water over the road during significant rain events.

This method allows vehicles to travel on the treated material sooner, meaning shorter duration of road closures from flooding and less disruption to the community.

What happens next?

From August 2023

- > Road restoration
- > Line marking
- > Green Ridge Road and Mundoolun Road junction bus stop relocation
- > Installation of lighting
- > Landscaping

Late 2023

What can I expect?



We will continue to make every effort to minimise disruption during the remaining works. However, some temporary construction impacts can be expected such as:

- > changed traffic conditions including reduced speed limits and detours (as needed). Traffic controllers will assist during working hours.
- > increased noise, dust, and vibration
- > temporary disruption to driveway access (affected residents will be notified).

Electronic signs will communicate changes. Motorists are encouraged to plan their journey and allow extra travel time.
