Loganlea Road Major Upgrade

Logan City Council is delivering a 2.3 km upgrade of Loganlea Road, from the Logan Motorway, Meadowbrook to the Pacific Motorway, Slacks Creek to reduce congestion and help get you home safely.

This project is funded in part by the *Australian Government Investment Road and Rail Program*.

This upgrade means:



More reliable travel times



Safer intersections



Improved connectivity to support Logan's southwest



Progress update April to August 2023

Since the upgrade commenced in April 2023, we've completed the following activities:

- > removal of vegetation and tree clearing
- > removal of the south-to-north U-turn facilities (detours are signed)
- > temporary closure of Translink bus stop 312596 (changes signed)
- > installation of temporary traffic safety barriers, signage and fencing
- > excavation works
- > temporary asphaltting and pavement construction
- > temporary pedestrian footpath changes (detours are signed).

We thank motorists and residents for their cooperation while we undertake these essential works.

Staying safe around road works

Construction involves a variety of activities, and ensuring the safety of workers and road users is critical.

Remain clear of construction

Spotters and traffic control officers are on site to safely assist the public around works, including temporary exclusion zones on private properties.

Follow signage and pedestrian paths

Please stay safe by following all instructions and remaining inside flagged paths.

Prepare for ongoing changes

Drive to conditions and be aware of upcoming changes.





What can I expect?

- › Standard construction hours 6 am to 6 pm Monday to Saturday. Local residents will be notified of outside hours works.
- › Changed traffic conditions including reduced speed limits, some shoulder/lane closures and detours (as needed).
- › Ongoing intermittent night works.
- › Electronic signs will communicate changes.

Motorists are encouraged to plan their journey and allow extra travel time.

Drone survey technology

Drone flights will occur intermittently throughout the project to capture progress and assist engineering and mapping.

Changes to Loganlea Road on-street parking

Residents in the work zone are requested to ensure all vehicles are parked inside private property. Please avoid parking on road shoulders, grassed verges or driveways during construction times.

Logan's road network commitment

The Loganlea Road Major Upgrade (Meadowbrook to Slacks Creek) is part of Council's \$850 million investment in roads and transport solutions from 2022–2026/27 to keep Logan moving.

With our city's population set to increase by more than 50 per cent by 2041, improving our road network is one of the ways we are unlocking Logan's potential and preparing for the future.

Other major upgrade projects include Chambers Flat Road from Mount Lindesay Highway to Kings Way, Mundoolun Road, Middle Road and Teviot Road roundabout.

What happens next?

From July 2023

- › Temporary closure of slip lanes at intersections
- › Temporary detours for U-turns at intersections
- › Power and water relocations
- › Traffic island and median works
- › Installation of temporary lighting
- › Pedestrian footpath works
- › Drainage works.

Works are subject to weather and site conditions.
