

A checklist to prepare your property for floods



Identify if your property may be at risk of flooding. The Logan Flood Portal allows you to view flood risk mapping for your area of interest. flood.logan.qld.gov.au

Download a Flood Report for your property from the Logan Flood Portal. flood.logan.qld.gov.au

Register for the Logan Early Warning service and download the app to get early alerts for potentially severe weather, bushfires, and flood notifications. logan.qld.gov.au/earlywarning

Check if there is a Flood Watch Camera near your property. disaster.logan.qld.gov.au/viewCameras

Prepare an emergency plan, including emergency contact numbers and other important phone numbers.

Include your pets in your emergency plan and identify where you are going to take your animals if you need to evacuate.

Check if you could be cut off by floodwaters, and plan the safest route to leave your property, should you decide to leave.

Prepare an emergency kit. logan.qld.gov.au/getprepared

Locate and pack your critical documentation (e.g. insurance, financial, legal and identification documents) in a portable waterproof container.

Identify any objects that would need to be secured or moved to a higher location.

Check whether there is adequate insurance to cover you in the event of a flood, and contact your insurance company to check if there are any specific preparations you need to make prior to the event.

Consider installing fence lines if you live on a rural property in such a way that your animals can move to higher ground in the event of flooding.
