

# Construction Update

## Chambers Flat Road Upgrade

February 2024

**SEE Civil is the appointed contractor to construct the 3.8 km Chambers Flat Road upgrade between Mount Lindesay Highway to just north of Kings Way.**

### Traffic changes – Zone 1 & 2

**From Tuesday 13 February 2024, the one-way traffic diversion will switch to the newly asphalted westbound lane between Norris Creek Bridge and Munruben Ambulance Station.**

For your safety, please follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.

SEE Civil's Community Relations Advisor will contact residents on the northern side of Zone 2 to discuss upcoming works and changes to property access.

***Please note weather and construction conditions may impact scheduled dates and work hours.***



### Construction activities

**Zone 1 – Ambulance Station to Norris Creek Road**  
**Zone 2 – 1866 to 1737 Chambers Flat Road**

- > resurfacing and traffic switch
- > priming and sealing driveways
- > constructing driveway access ramps
- > installing road and driveway drainage
- > constructing pavements and driveways

- > undertaking earthworks requiring plant and trucks
- > constructing replacement fencing
- > installing landscaping and line marking.

### Zone 3 – Norris Creek Bridge

**Another major milestone will be reached when 90 precast bridge girders are installed in coming weeks.**

- > the final concrete pour for headstocks to support the girders is schedule for the start of February 2024.
- > eight different types of girders range between 16.3 meters to 21 meters long, weighing between 18 to 25 tonnes.
- > girders will be installed in stages from 19 – 28 February 2024, weather permitting.
- > 500 tonne and 230 tonne mobile cranes will be used.
- > seeing the girders in place will really start to bring home the magnitude of this project.

### Zone 3 – Norris Creek sidetrack emergency closures

The Norris Creek bridge westbound one-way sidetrack may again be closed again over the coming storm season if it floods. The flooding is caused by heavy rain in the Norris Creek catchment combined with tidal backup of floodwaters in the Logan River.

Residents and road users must not proceed beyond safety barriers which may be put in place at short notice – if it's flooded, forget it.

**It is a serious offence to move road safety barriers, bollards, or other road safety devices and to ignore road closure signs. These will be monitored.**

Any access arrangements required for residents of Greenvale Road during future flooding will be notified via SEE Civil email subscription or the project webpage [www.logan.qld.gov.au/chambersflatroad](http://www.logan.qld.gov.au/chambersflatroad).

### Zone 3 – Greenvale Road intersection

- > a sidetrack is being built to assist with traffic control during the upgrade of this intersection.
- > traffic changes are to be expected in the coming weeks.
- > upgrading the intersection will provide safer turning movements and a dedicated turning lane will enhance the traffic flow.
- > new street lighting will be installed.
- > SEE Civil's Community Relations Advisor will be in contact with affected residents with further information on upcoming works and impacts to residents.

### Zone 4 – 1545 Chambers Flat Road to Riverina Court

We were pleased to see the new Zone 4 lanes opened in both directions in late December 2023 and the removal of the temporary traffic lights at Kings Way and Riverina Court.

Zone 4 works are in the final stages including:

- > topsoil and landscaping works
- > final driveway construction activities
- > installing road signage and completing line marking
- > fencing replacement
- > bus stop construction
- > concrete open drain construction.

### What to expect

- > temporary traffic changes — reduced speed limits, assisted property access, traffic controls and direction of traffic to allow shifting of machinery and materials
- > frequent changes to lane and road alignments
- > odour during asphaltting and sealing works
- > increased truck movements
- > temporary property access changes
- > changes for residents within Zone 1 & 2 (northern side), once traffic has switched onto the new westbound alignment, your bins will now be collected from the westbound lane. If you require assistance moving your bin across, please contact SEE Civil's Community Liaison Officer to arrange assistance
- > increased noise, dust and vibration
- > earlier start times for bridge girder installation, residents will be notified ahead.

Weather and construction conditions may impact scheduled work hours.

### Important road safety notice

**Motorists and residents are reminded the Chambers Flat Road eastbound lane remains closed within Zones 1 and 2.**

**In response to illegal eastbound travel on the westbound one-way lane, we have implemented additional safety measures including monitoring systems and reporting non-compliance to the authorities. Heavy infringement fines apply.**

Traffic changes including closures, switches and detours are in place to protect road users' and workers' safety throughout the construction footprint.

Please obey road signs and requests of traffic controllers and remain vigilant of other motorists while driving through the construction zones.
