

# Mundoolun Road Rehabilitation Project

Project update, March 2024



In January 2023, Logan City Council commenced upgrading 4.5 kilometers of Mundoolun Road, from just south of the East Street roundabout to just north of Monmouth Court, and from John Collins Drive to Collins Creek Road.

## The rectification works will deliver:



A new road surface



Improved road conditions and safety



Improved travel times as the speed limit is restored upon completion of works.

## Project update

Soon after the project was completed in December 2023, we became aware of potholes and surface deterioration on the new road surface.

Bitumen was observed coming through the new stone surface, which is called flushing or bleeding. This resulted in excess bitumen at the road surface, particularly in the wheel paths.

We have been working with our contractor to develop a plan of action to rectify the issue.

Our contractor has developed a permanent solution to address the failures in the pavement surface.

## When is it happening?

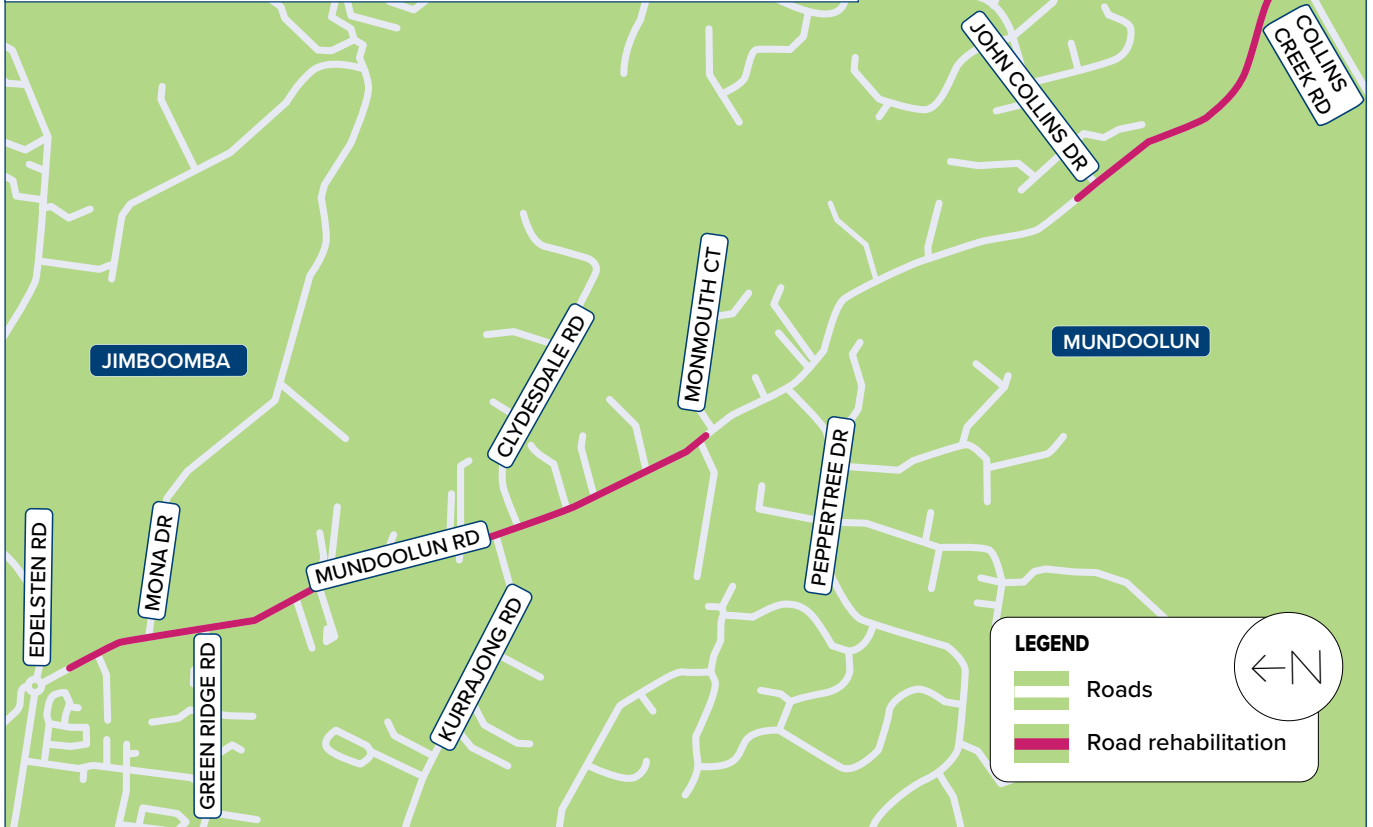


Rectification works are expected to commence from 2 April 2024 and finish in late May 2024, weather and construction conditions permitting.

Construction activities will generally occur from Monday to Friday, 7:00 am to 6:00 pm. If works are required to be completed outside of these hours, nearby residents will be notified.

## What can I expect?

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption during the works. However, some temporary construction impacts can be expected. Motorists are encouraged to plan their journeys and allow extra travel time.



## Temporary impacts

- › Changed traffic conditions including reduced speed limits, lane closures and detours (as needed)
- › Increased noise, dust and vibration
- › Temporary disruption to driveway access

## What we are doing

- › Traffic controllers will manage detours and road or lane closures during working hours
- › Electronic signs will be installed to communicate changes
- › Affected residents will be notified in advance of changes to parking and driveway access

We recognise the inconvenience the project has had on the community and thank residents and motorists for their patience and ongoing cooperation as we work to address the pavement surface issues.
