EAGLEBY MASTER DRAINAGE UPGRADE | PROJECT UPDATE

What is happening – recommencement of works

I am pleased to announce that Council is in the process of appointing **BMD Constructions** to complete the open sections of work on the Eagleby master drainage upgrade. You can expect to see their crews on site from Monday 20 May 2024, subject to weather and sub-contractor availability.

Once on site, BMD will be able to fully assess the status of existing works and prepare a new schedule for the necessary construction These works include completion of:

- stormwater pits & pipes
- kerb and channel
- pavement construction and road surfacing
- driveway reinstatement & auxiliary works

Council appreciates residents' patience while a new contractor was secured. Council has allocated the additional funds required for a new contractor to finish the commenced works.

Short term road repairs

In the meantime, road repair works have been taking place which will include applying a dust blocking agent to the streets. These repairs are a temporary solution until BMD can re-commence the drainage works in each location.

Council crews continue to respond to requests to patch potholes and ensure open drainage works are fenced until works can recommence.
