

# **Chambers Flat Road Upgrade**

Project update, April 2024



Logan City Council is upgrading 3.8 km of Chambers Flat Road, from Mount Lindesay Highway, Munruben, to just north of Kings Way, Chambers Flat.

These upgrades mean:



Improved road safety as traffic grows



Improved connectivity to support Logan's southwest



Reduced road closures during wet weather events



# Milestone update December 2023 to April 2024

#### **New Norris Creek Bridge takes shape**

Following piling works in October, the next major parts of the new Norris Creek Bridge are complete. Over three days in March, a 500 tonne, all-terrain crane lifted 90 concrete girders into place for the new bridge decks. Activities are ongoing, including construction of the new roadway.

The upgraded crossing has been raised by 8 metres for better access during severe wet weather.

The bridge opening is expected in late 2024.

#### First sections of new alignment opened

The first section of the new Chambers Flat Road alignment opened to both directions from Riverina Court to Grevellia Road, in December last year.

This was followed by the opening of the westbound lane from Greenvale Road to Mount Lindesay Highway in March. Construction is ongoing for the new eastbound alignment.

### **Improved Kings Way intersection**

Opening of the Kings Way intersection in December 2023 saw the end of a signalised detour. Road users have been returned to quicker journeys towards Munruben Ambulance Station.

### What's next



Upcoming milestones include:

- opening of both lanes from Greenvale Road to Munruben Ambulance Station
- > opening of the new Norris Creek Bridge
- upgrades to intersections at Grevillea Road and Greenvale Road
- > landscaping, line marking, and signage.
