

Notice of works

Reconstruction works – New Beith Road, Greenbank

Logan City Council is commencing pavement reconstruction works from the intersection of Lyon Drive and heading 120m South along New Beith Road.

What is happening?



Pavement reconstruction works include:

- › reconstruction of the road pavement
- › excavation works
- › associated road drainage works
- › removal of vegetation and tree clearing within Council Road reserve as required.

We have appointed a contractor Naric Civil to undertake these works.

When is it happening?



Works are scheduled from July to August 2024, site and weather conditions permitting.

Works will generally occur Monday to Friday, between 6:00 am to 6:00 pm. Should works extend beyond these hours, we will notify affected residents.

Project funding



These works are aimed at reconstructing the road and drainage network in our city following the major rain event of 2022.

This project is being delivered under Council's Reconstruction of Essential Public Assets (REPA) program. It is jointly funded by the Commonwealth and State funded Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangement (DRFA) program.

What can I expect?



Every effort will be made to minimise disruption to traffic and local residents during these works. However, some temporary impacts can be expected.

Temporary impacts

- › Changed traffic conditions including reduced speed limits, short term lane closure and detours (as needed).
- › Increased noise, dust and vibration.
- › Temporary disruption to driveway access. Affected residents will be notified in advance.

How are we assisting?

- › Traffic control and site representatives to assist motorists.
- › Traffic changes will be communicated via electronic signs. Motorists are encouraged to plan their journey and allow extra travel time.
