Teviot Road Upgrade

Logan City Council is investing in our growing neighbourhoods with new and upgraded roads, parks and drainage. This includes network upgrades across our city's southwest to help residents get home safer and sooner.

With traffic in Greenbank set to increase with local residential and business development, we're making major improvements to Teviot Road. These multi-stage upgrades will mean Teviot Road remains fits for purpose now and into the future.

The Teviot Road upgrade will deliver:



Improved safety



More reliable travel times



Better traffic flow

What is happening?

From late August 2024, we're undertaking widening and improvement works on Teviot Road, from the Greenbank Shopping Centre, to just south of the Greenbank Community Centre (James Smith Recreation Area).

Stage 1A will include:


- > widening Teviot Road to four lanes
- > building wider shoulders in both directions
- > new stormwater infrastructure and kerbing to improve road and verge drainage
- > new traffic signals at Leanne Court
- > improved walking and cycling paths
- > associated relocation of water and electrical services plus restoration activities
- > some vegetation removal and tree trimming.


We have appointed BMD Constructions Pty Ltd to undertake these works.

When is it happening?

Construction is scheduled to commence from late August 2024 and conclude in mid-2025. Works are expected to take approximately 10 months, pending site and weather conditions.

Construction activities will generally occur between 7:00 am and 6:00 pm, Monday to Saturday. If works are required outside these hours, nearby residents and businesses will be notified.







What can I expect?

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption during the works. However, some temporary construction impacts can be expected. Road users are encouraged to plan their journey and allow extra travel time.

Temporary impacts

- Changed traffic conditions including reduced speed limits, road or lane closures and detours (as needed)
- > increased noise, dust, and vibration
- temporary loss of street parking and driveway access
- temporary footpath closures and bus stop relocation
- > tree and vegetation removal, as required.

What are we doing?

- > Traffic controllers will be available for detours and road or lane closures during working hours
- > electronic signs will be installed to communicate traffic changes.

Affected residents will be notified in advance of changes to parking, driveway access, and footpath closures.
