What is happening?

We are making it easier to visit one of our city's most popular cultural and sporting precincts at Underwood Road, Priestdale.

From 9 September, we will convert the end of Underwood Road to a sealed turning circle. A new tourist coach set down area will be installed in front of the Chung Tian Temple. These changes will enable a potential future Translink route extension, effectively addressing safety concerns, enhancing tourism, and improving public transport options.

Upgrades include:

- construction of a sealed turning cul-de-sac at the end of Underwood Road
- a new set down/boarding point for tourist coaches and buses
- a new footpath for safer walking and riding
- road resurfacing from Underwood Park access road to Daisy Hill Conservation Park access.
- stormwater drainage improvements
- new kerb and channel at the cul-de-sac head
- retaining wall and landscaping
- new signage and linemarking.

What you can expect

We aim to minimise disruption; however temporary impacts may include:

- changed traffic conditions and delays
- noise, dust, and vibration
- reduced speed limits
- potential night works for resurfacing activities.

Be prepared:

- Temporary lane closures and switches
- Expect delays and allow extra travel time.
- For safety, follow signed directions and crew instructions.
