<b>Where</b>	42 Quinzeh Creek Rd, Logan Village QLD 4207
<b>When</b>	<b>Start</b> September 2024 <b>Finish</b> January 2025
<b>Work hours</b>	6:30am to 4:30pm – Monday to Friday However, some works may extend outside these hours.
<b>What is happening</b>	Rehabilitation and widening on Quinzeh Creek Road in front of Opal Retirement Village. Works will include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• installation of a left turn slip lane into Opal Retirement Village</li><li>• reinstatement of footpath and cycle way</li><li>• turf and landscape works</li><li>• line marking as per map overleaf.</li></ul>
<b>Please note</b>	Start and finish dates may change due to weather or construction conditions.

## WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

Temporary construction impacts include:

- Lane closure, reduced speed limits and footpath closure around work sites (see map overleaf).
- Noise, dust, vibration and flashing lights from trucks and machinery.
- Vegetation removal and / or trimming in Council Road reserve as required.
