

Teviot Road and Cusack Lane Intersection Upgrade

South MacLean and Riverbend



We are improving road safety with support from the Australian Government.

This intersection upgrade will help reduce the risk of crashes and improve safety for all road users.

This upgrade means:



a safer intersection



Improved visibility in low light conditions



better traffic flow and more reliable travel times

What is happening?

We're improving safety at the intersection of Teviot Road and Cusack Lane at the border of South Maclean and Riverbend.

This project is delivered with support from the Australian Government's Black Spot Program.

The upgrade will help reduce the risk of potential crashes and enhance safety for all road users.

Features include:

- › installing traffic signals for safer movement
- › additional lighting to improve visibility in low-light conditions
- › dividing medians to protect vehicles in turning lanes
- › pedestrian crossings
- › bicycle lanes approaching the intersection on Teviot Road.

We have appointed DOVAL Constructions (QLD) Ltd to undertake these upgrade works.

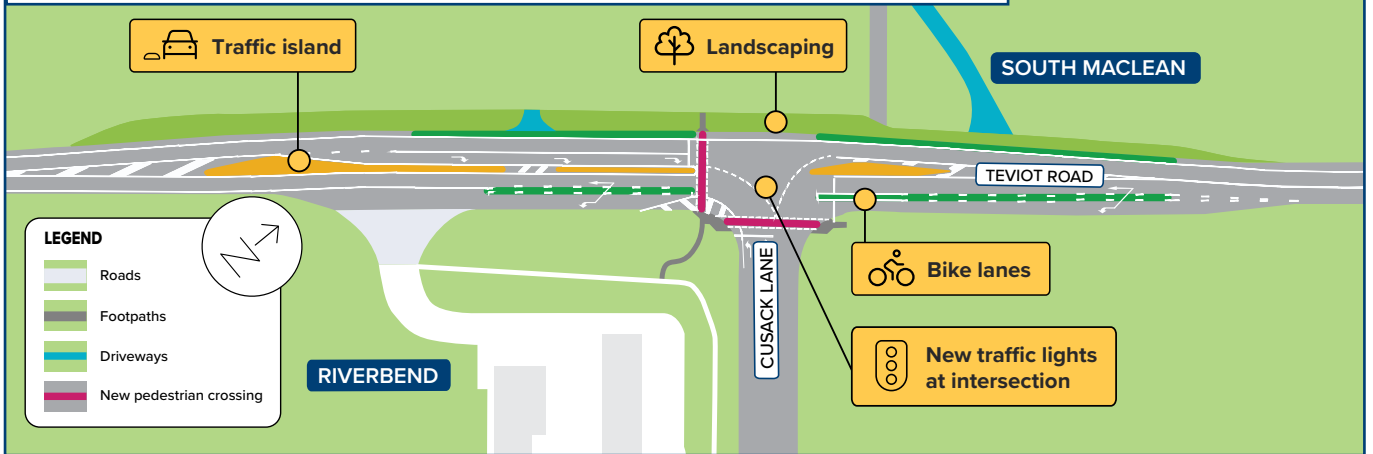
When is it happening?

Construction is scheduled to commence in September 2024, pending site and weather conditions.

Activities will generally occur between 7:00am to 6:00pm from Monday to Saturday, excluding public holidays. If works are required outside these hours, nearby residents will be notified.

What can I expect?

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption during the works. However, some temporary construction impacts can be expected. Road users are encouraged to plan their journey and allow extra travel time.

Temporary impacts

- > Changed traffic conditions including detours, reduced speed limits and road or lane closures (as needed)
- > increased noise, dust, and vibration
- > temporary footpath closures.

What are we doing?

- > Traffic controllers will be available for detours and road or lane closures during working hours
- > electronic signs will be in place to communicate traffic changes
- > affected residents will be notified in advance of changes to parking, driveway access, and footpath closures.

Project funding

This project is being delivered with support from the Australian Government's Black Spot Program. The Black Spot Program was introduced as part of the Australian Government's commitment to reduce crashes. The program targets locations where crashes have occurred or are at high risk of happening.

Other local Black Spot program upgrades include:

- > Clarke Road/Park Ridge Road intersection Black Spot Project, Park Ridge
- > Chambers Flat Road (Holloway Road to Kenny Road) Black Spot Project, Chambers Flat
- > Millstream Road Black Spot Project, Cedar Vale.
