## What is happening?

We are undertaking repairs to sections of Goodna Road, Greenbank to improve road safety. The repairs will address water pooling and shoulder drop off which creates a hazard for drivers particularly during wet weather.

The works will include:

- · Shoulder grading
- Drain cleaning
- · Shoulder gravel resheeting
- Driveway culvert cleaning
- Guidepost replacement
- removal of vegetation (grass/topsoil) within the road reserve where required.

## When is it happening?

Works are scheduled for October to November 2024, weather and site conditions permitting.

To avoid traffic delays, works will generally occur during the night from 6.00pm to 5.30am Sunday to Thursday. However, some works may occur outside these hours.

## What can I expect?

We aim to minimise disruption during these works however, some localised construction impacts are unavoidable including:

- Changed traffic conditions with lane closures and reduced speed limits
- Truck movements to and from the work site to facilitate delivery of materials and equipment, and removal of excavated material
- Increased levels of noise and dust. Council's workers will attempt to reduce this impact as much as practical.
