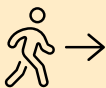


We are upgrading two local intersections for better road safety.

This project will improve access to the nearby town square, transit centre and shopping areas.

Planning for our future

What's happening?

We're upgrading intersections on Alamein Street at George and Main streets in Beenleigh.

The upgrades will provide improved traffic flow, more reliable travel times and safer movement for motorists, bike riders and pedestrians.

As the major ring road around the Beenleigh Town Centre, Alamein Street experiences significant pedestrian activity due to its proximity to the transit centre and adjacent businesses.

George Street intersection upgrade includes:

- > new traffic signals
- > CCTV camera monitoring
- > modified traffic islands
- > new kerb, channel and ramps
- > landscaping.

Main Street intersection upgrade includes:

- > new traffic signals
- > changes to the existing footpath, including new kerb ramp
- > reconstructed traffic nose cone
- > new block wall
- > pavement resurfacing.

When is it happening?



Construction is scheduled to start in early November 2024 and expected to conclude in mid-2025 (construction and weather conditions permitting).

To minimise traffic disruptions, most works will take place at night between 8 pm - 5 am, Sunday to Wednesday, and 9 pm - 5 am on Thursdays.

If activities are required during daytime hours, nearby residents and businesses will be notified.

What can I expect?



Every effort will be made to minimise disruption, however some temporary impacts can be expected. Road users are encouraged to plan their journey and allow extra travel time.

Temporary impacts

- > Changed traffic conditions including reduced speed limits, road or path closures and detours
- > Increased noise, dust, and vibration
- > Temporary loss of street parking

What are we doing?

- > Detours will be in place
- > Changes will be signed
- > Impacted properties or businesses will be notified

Our road network commitment



These projects are part of Council's investment in roads and transport solutions to keep our city moving.
