Goodna Road, Greenbank

December 2024 - January 2025

Division 11 Councillor Natalie Willcocks and City Infrastructure Chair Scott Bannan are pleased to announce the commencement of works in your local area.

What is happening?

We are completing upgrades to the existing Carparks on Goodna Road opposite to the Greenbank State School (along the southbound lane). Works will include pavement treatment and asphalting. See map overleaf for details.

When is it happening?

Works are scheduled to take place during the December 2024 / January 2025 school holidays, weather and site conditions permitting.

Works will generally occur from 7.00am to 6.00pm Monday to Saturday. However, due to the nature of the works, some activities may occur outside these hours at times.

What can I expect?

We will aim to minimise disruption during these works. Some localised construction impacts are expected including:

- Speed restrictions, lane closures and footpath closures around work sites. Site representatives will be available to assist motorists and pedestrians during construction working hours as required.
- Temporary loss of street parking.
- Increased levels of noise and dust. We will attempt to reduce this impact as much as practical.

We thank you for your patience and cooperation while these essential works are carried out and apologise for any inconvenience you may experience during these works.
