

Application for Free Medical Assistance Extra Bins

If you generate excess waste or recycling because of a medical condition, you can apply for a free extra bin or bins.

An example is a home dialysis patient, who will have excess plastic waste, cardboard, and containers to deal with because of the dialysis process.

For health and safety, bins must not be used to dispose of medical equipment containing liquids or bodily fluids.

Place sharps in a sealed puncture-proof container before disposal in the waste bin.

Page 3 must be completed by a medical practitioner.

The service can be cancelled at any time if no longer required. We will remove the extra bin or bins.

Free Medical Assistance Extra Bins are valid for 3 years. Residents will need to reapply to have the service continue.
